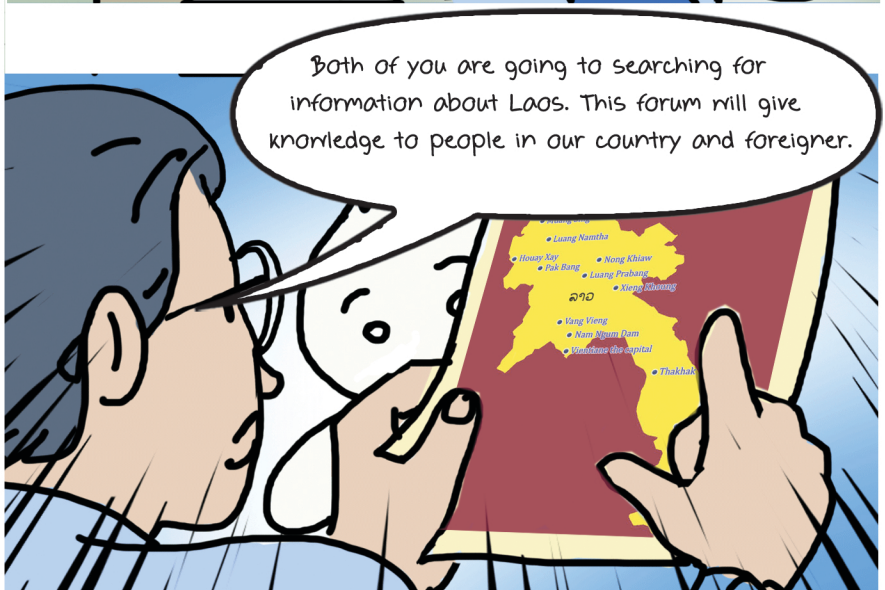

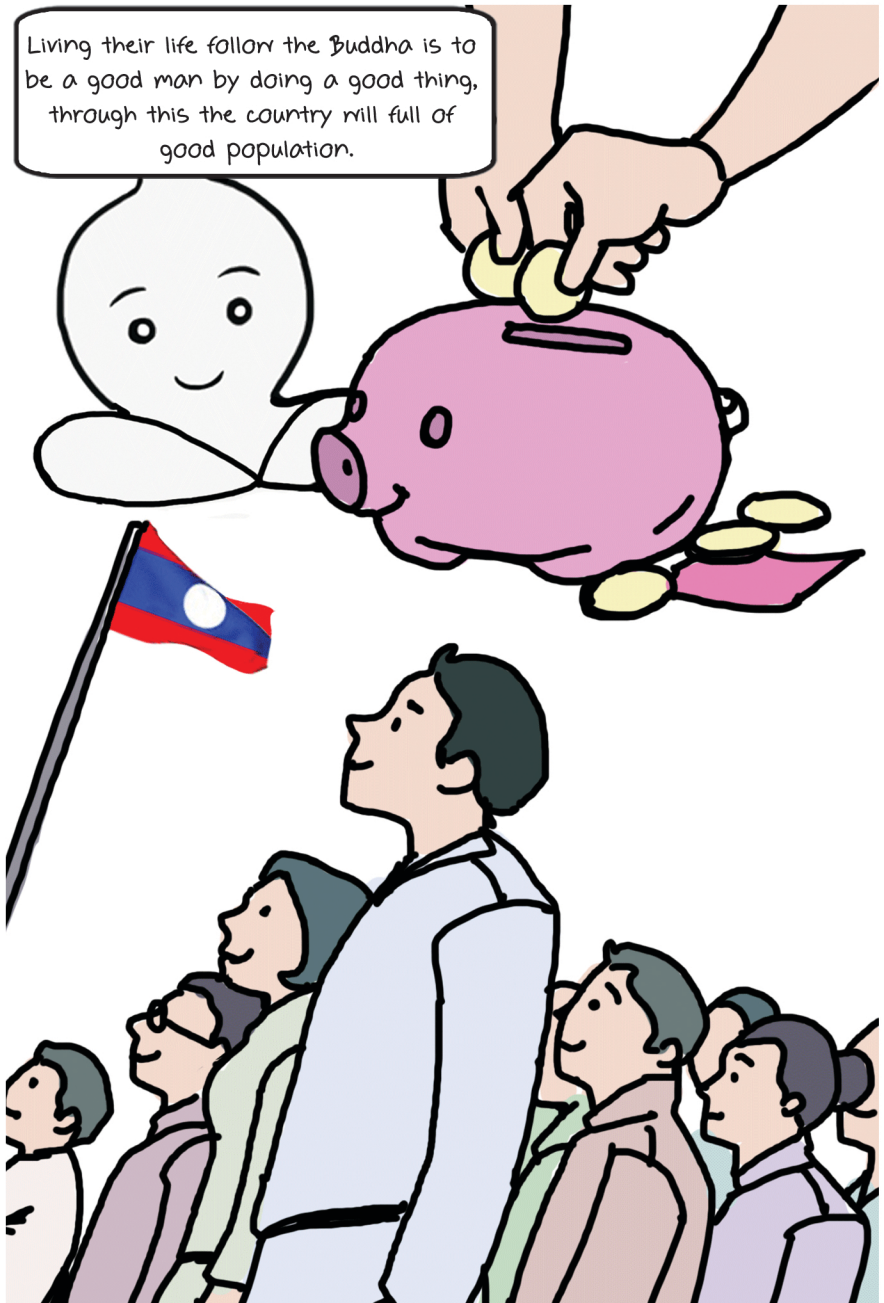




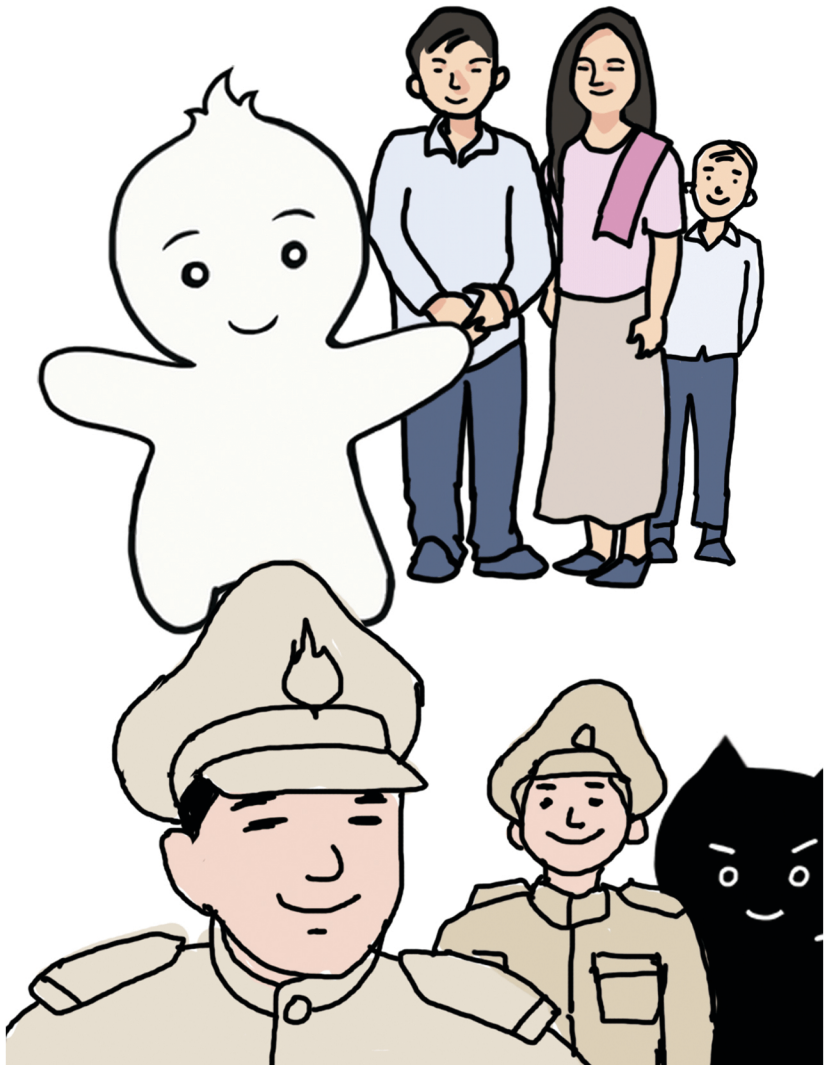


Monks and Buddhist novices are one of the ways to make their life doing well and have a good social value about life including loving their country and economize.
